Mr. Sharma received his Civil Engineering degree in 1971 and Post Graduate degree in Civil Engineering (Structures) with Honours in 1978 from the University of Delhi.

He worked in the Ministry of Roads and Highways in various posts from 1972 to 2006. On deputation, he served NHAI as General Manager/ Chief General Manager from 1997 to 2003.

He worked as the first full-time Secretary/ Secretary General of the Indian Roads Congress during the period 2003 to 2006 and was responsible for the development of a number of Codes, and the organisation of a number of workshops, national and international seminars, Annual Sessions and Council meetings.

After taking Voluntary retirement from government service as Chief Engineer in November 2006, he has been working in the Consultancy Sector. He has been a member of Governing Council of CEAI for over 12 years and its Treasure for 8 years. During that period, he has served on various Committees and organised Seminars. He is a Life Member of CEAI. As a recognition of his outstanding contribution to the highway sector, he has been honoured with the Life Time Achievement Award by the Indian Roads Congress for the year 2022.

He has over 50 years of professional experience and a distinguished career. He commands considerable respect in the government, consultancy, and contracting industry in India.

- Appointment of the Auditors for the Financial Year 2022-2023.








