

# WEBINAR ON "DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION OF NATM SCISSOR CROSSOVER FOR MUMBAI UNDERGROUND METRO"

The second webinar organised by the YP Forum of CEAI was held on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2023 on "Design & Construction of NATM Scissor Crossover for Mumbai Underground Metro".

The presentation was made by Mr. Prathap Muniyappa, Lead Designer (Tunnel & Geotechnical), Geo-consult India Pvt. Ltd.

Mr. Muniyappa briefed that the construction of underground structures for the metro rail projects is always challenging as the project works normally affect many adjacent surface structures which have stringent settlement criteria and protection requirements. Project implementation becomes even more complex when the overburden is shallow and the area of the cross-section is comparatively large as was the case for the *crossover structure which had to be constructed between the twin TBM Bored tunnels*. For optimized construction feasibility, construction staging and geotechnical stability of the excavation are critical, hence detailed design of the primary support and modified construction sequence was carried out in accordance with the principles of NATM design.

## WEBINAR ON "ETHICS & INTEGRITY AT THE WORKPLACE"

CEAI organised a webinar on "Ethics & Integrity at the Workplace" on 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023 to advocate ethical practices amongst the consulting fraternity in their day-to-day functioning.

Mr. R S Sharma, President CEAI in his opening remarks briefed about CEAI and its activities and said that the ethics and integrity are the two pivotal areas of CEAI. He welcomed the speakers and participants to the webinar.

## **CONSTRUCTION LAW COURSE**

CEAI Western Region Centre has organised a "*Construction Law Course*" starting from 10<sup>th</sup> June 2023 at the Indian Merchants' Chamber, Churchgate, Mumbai.

## **Objective of the Course**

The boom in construction has brought in its wake increased litigation. That primarily stems from lack of proper understanding of the laws that govern construction contracts.



The Consulting Engineers Association of India, has held very successful seminars, workshops and courses on contracts, arbitration, professional indemnity, et al in which there were extensive and intensive interactions between the faculty, the participants and the organisers. The feedbacks received called for a course on Construction Law.

In response to those requests the Consulting Engineers Association of India has in the interest of national development and the professionals associated with construction projects, tailor made a course on Construction Law which would educate the attendee on the nuances of law as applicable to avoid disputes for Clients/ Owners/ Employers, Construction Companies, Vendors & Suppliers, and Consultants so that the project is completed as intended.

The course will be held over weekends (Saturdays & Sundays) 10:00 am to 12:00 pm IST, starting from 10<sup>th</sup> June 2023 and ending on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2023. **Time will be given for interaction with the faculty.** 

The course will be based on The Indian Contract Act, 1872; The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996; The Indian Evidence Act, 1872; The Limitation Act, 1963; and Professional Liability. It will cover:

- Engineering Law
- Contractual Problems of Project Execution
- Mechanism of Amicable Settlement of Differences
- Practical Application i/c holding a Moot Court

The Moot Court and an Exam will be held at the end of the Course and Certificates will be awarded to the participants who attend 75% of the lectures of the course.

Physical participation by persons from outside Mumbai is required only for 2 days; 10<sup>th</sup> June and 12<sup>th</sup> August 2023.

### **VIEWPOINT**

The theme for the June issue is "Climate Resilient Infrastructure".

The world has been witnessing unprecedented natural phenomena which are causing widespread destruction. Many reasons are given for that. Be what they may, however, with the country undergoing rapid transformation in its Infrastructure sector, that is the sector for which the maximum care needs to be taken to address the effects of Climate Change. Infrastructure development affects people the most. In that again the transportation sectors – the people and goods movers, comprising roads, highways, bridges, railways, metros, airports, and ports result in large-scale changes to the natural topography, flora, and fauna. Housing, water & wastewater, stormwater drainage, power, telecommunication, etc. also affect everyone, especially in built-up areas. The investments in all these are enormous and so are the efforts to make them fructify. It is therefore up to the Engineers who conceptualise, plan, design, construct and maintain to do so in a manner that is not only sustainable but also addresses the issues of climate change. It is also necessary that the end products can withstand the vagaries of nature for their design service life. Case Studies could also be given where IoT has been used for Infrastructure works provided with sensors and real-time monitoring systems for better control and to provide advance warning by identifying vulnerabilities or abnormal behaviour thereby allowing for a faster and more timely response.

Professionals involved in the above developments are requested to share their experiences, learnings, and how they have addressed the issues.
